Tip

## **Bundling Prompts**

If the document is short, it's OK to bundle your prompts and fix spelling, punctuation, and grammar all at once. If the document is long or if it's in rough shape, unbundle to fix one error type at a time.

Tip **02** 

## **Explanations**

Prompt the GenAl to list the changes it suggests or it made. Do this if you're trying to improve your writing skills or need to explain to someone else how the document was changed.

Tip **03** 

## **Consistent Style**

Give the GenAl tool your house style guide's rules and ask it to check the document for consistency with those rules.

Tip **04** 

#### **Fact Checking**

Tell the GenAI tool the facts (or a source for identifying them) and ask it to check the document for consistency with those facts.

Tip **05** 

#### **Change Management**

If the document is more than one page, ask the GenAl tool to check it in sections so you can more easily review the results.

Tip **06** 

### More Change Management

Ask the GenAl tool to make its changes in boldface to make it easier for you to identify the changes it made.

## **Wise Delegation**

Rely on the GenAl tool for tasks you hate or aren't good at. Hate checking citations? Yeah, the GenAl should check those for you.
